The activities conducted and attended in Quarter III and IV and brief details of each activity are mentioned below:


1. Talk on "From your Ph.D./ Master's Thesis to a start-up

Prof. Anil Sahastrabuddhe started the session by enlightening on the importance of the Entrepreneurship. He said, the problem of Masters or PhD research can be converted to a startups. PhD is a good training for entrepreneurship.

He also discussed the components of the lean approach and elaborated on how one can have an iterative processes through lean approach – build-measure-learn.

The various techniques to articulate the problems need to be used. Further, he said, PhD thesis may have been a solo project however, an entrepreneurship is all about teamwork.

He gave a reference of the book "Beyond the Summit" and shared his thoughts about how to build a team. The entrepreneurs should see to it that how he is complying to the needs of the customers better than the competitors.






2. Session on "Why IP is important in academia?"

Dr. Abhay Jere elaborated the importance of intellectual property. He said, the researchers and academicians should convert the knowledge into wealth through innovation, product development, startups, and different ventures.

The theme of intellectual property is extremely important for India. If we want to emerge as five Trillian dollar economy, then we have to strengthen our manufacturing sector that can be only done through our MSMEs. We need to have huge amount of MSMEs, for creation of employment on large scale.

Large number of ideas need to be generated, and ensure that those ideas need to be converted in enterprises. Youngsters need to be motivated to encash on demographic dividend, get out of the mindset of getting only marks, and start looking at ideas, problems which we can solve.

He informed that government has announced Kapila initiative where government expects that higher education institutes to go ahead and file Intellectual property.








3. Webinar on "Government Schemes for Entrepreneurs & their advantages"






4. Webinar on "Intellectual Property Rights"





6. I 2 E Ideation Competition 2021


