

Report on Outbound Training Programme-2019

With an aim of enhancing team performance through experiential learning, Yashaswi's International Institute of Management Science organised an **Outbound Training Programme** on **October 2nd, 2019** for the MBA Students. The Outbound training programme was organised at **Kamet Adventure, 27 Kms from KanhePhata.**

The Objective of the programme was to—

- To understand the individual and team behaviours, and make the students experience the relevant aspects of intra-personal and interpersonal management.
- To bring an improvement in the areas of teamwork, team bonding, communication, leadership, time management, problem solving, decision making, motivation, change and personal development.

60 Students and 12 Staff Members from the institute participated in the training programme organised by Kamset Adventure under the leadership of Mr Rajesh Pathade. The Bus from the institute started at 7.00am and reached the adventure site at 9.00 am in the morning. After a light breakfast, the students were briefed about do's and don'ts of trekking by Mr Pathade and his team. The trekking started around 9.30 am .With the Sun playing hide and seek in the clouds, the students and staff members trekked through the trails of KamshetGhatti developing their critical management and leadership skills. The trekking site boasts of a network of cascading waterfalls. After the trekking the students enjoyed under a 200ft waterfall. The trekking ended at 1.00 pm. Lunch was organised at the campsite. After the Lunch, the students were engaged in rock climbing and rappelling. The students mastered the art of belaying, the partner based rope system that supports climbers while they are on the rock. After the session, tea and snacks was served to the students and staffs by the trainers. **Dean Dr RajendraSabnis and Director Dr ShivajiMundhe expressed their thanks to Mr Rajesh Pathade for excellently guiding the students.** The students also shared their experiences of the day. The students and staff members started from the campsite at 4.00pm and reached the institute at around 6.00pm in the evening. This outbound training program gave an opportunity to students from diverse geographical background to work closely with their peers in the form of training activities, analytically solving problems, leadership and team building activities.
