Dr.Bhave advised that 5 W- What, When, Where, Why, Who should be practiced by us to be successful.

Mr. Vinod Bidwaik, Vice-president- HR and CHRO (Cluster India, Middle East, Africa), Alpha Laval:

Mr. Vinod Bidwaiksaid, right mind-set, right skill set and right tools set is important in corporate world to become successful. The student should make themselves competitive, as there is a competition in corporate world.

He advised students to understand and master the employability skills like confidence and selfimage, decision making skills, English Language, agility, taking initiative, networking and influencing, goal setting and clarity in life priorities, professionalism, attitude and approach.

He emphasized on the reading skills. The reading habit and skills can help in corporate world to be up to date and informative.

He narrated the capabilities for the new work place- arch making, social intelligence, novel and adaptive thinking, cross- cultural competency, computational thinking, and new media literacy, Transdisciplinarity, cognitive load management, design mind-set and virtual collaboration.


