An industrial visit to Satara Mega Food Park, Kay Power and Paper Limited, Satara & Anand agro tourism borgaon, Satara, was organized by the Yashaswi Education Society International institute of management science (IIMS), Chinchwad, Pune on 16 April-2025 for MBA & MCA Students. The purpose of the visit was to provide students with practical insights into the working environment of the industry and to bridge the gap between theoretical knowledge and real-world practices.

The visit started with Satara Mega Food Park which is a part of the Ministry of Food Processing Industries (MoFPI) initiative, designed to provide a comprehensive platform for food processing businesses. Ketaki Madam, assistant HR-Training & development, provides details information about company profile and all the rules and regulation of industry. The industry offers state-of-the-art infrastructure and facilities for entrepreneurs in the food sector, including cold storage, warehousing, packaging, quality control labs, and logistics support. The Satara food park located in farmer hubs area where the farmers have opportunity to directly connect with industry with their raw product. Our students have seen the process carry out in industry from raw material to finished goods. They observed the whole process of production to testing laboratory of food product. The visit to Satara Mega Food Park was an enriching and educational experience for all the students. It provided a real-world understanding of food industry operations and the importance of infrastructure in agri-business. The insights gained will be highly valuable in aligning academic learning with industry practices.
